

2027 MacQueen Bursary

The CPHVA Education and Development Trust invites applications for the MacQueen Bursary 2027 from Health Visitors, School Nurses, and Community Public Health Nursing Teams.

What can I use a MacQueen Bursary for?

Applications are invited to fund any of the following activities:

- **Practice development** initiatives to facilitate the health and wellbeing of individuals, families, groups, or communities.
 - A **research project** focused on the enhancement of practice in community settings.
 - Engagement in **professional or academic study** activities to enhance the applicant's practice.
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Application criteria

All applications must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be **current members of UNITE/CPHVA**.
- Applicants will need to state the **total amount they are seeking** and should include a **detailed costing for the project** or study activity. Priority will be given to the shortlisted applications that demonstrate the greatest potential to enhance practice.

Note: Bursaries can only be awarded to the individual and not an employing organisation.

How do I apply?

We will be accepting applications twice throughout 2026 (Cohort 1: Closed, Cohort 2: 1st October - 31st December 2026). To apply:
